TTISS-ON Monthly Memo, aims to report back to you “real time”.

Approximately 81% of ATEs are reported to TTISS-ON as minor; FNHTR, minor allergic and delayed serological. There were 148 moderate to severe reactions reported from January 1st to June 30th 2019*.

Although not mandatory, we encourage all sites to report minor reactions!

Thanks to Matthew Yan for contributing the case study and to all those who participated! The reaction was reported as TAD. This would reportable to TTISS. For breakdown of responses:

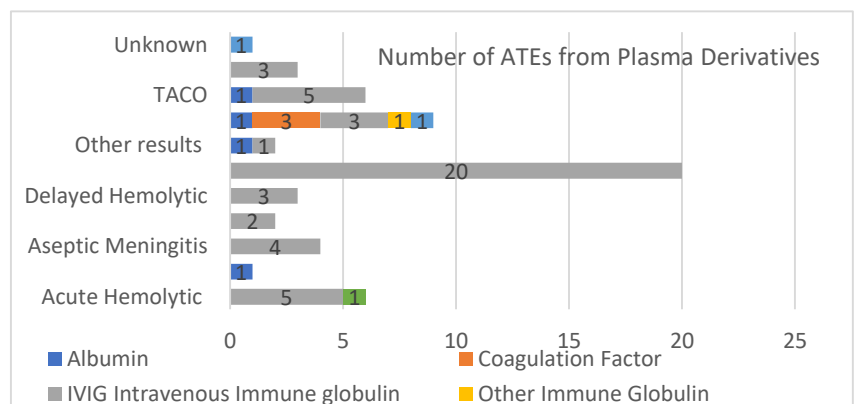
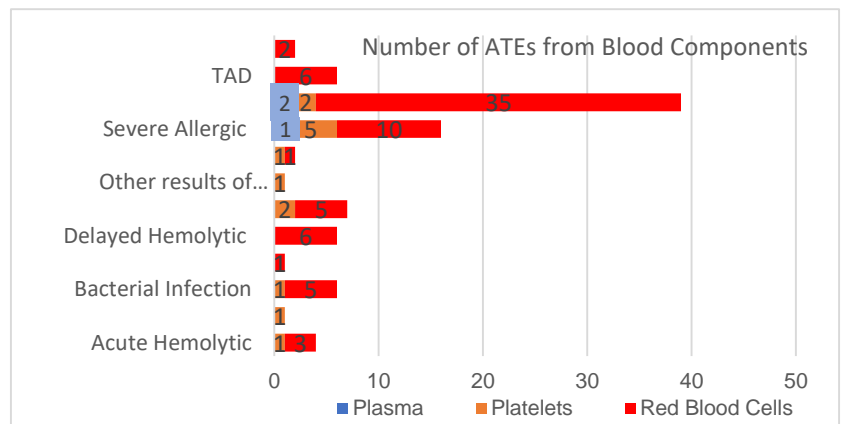
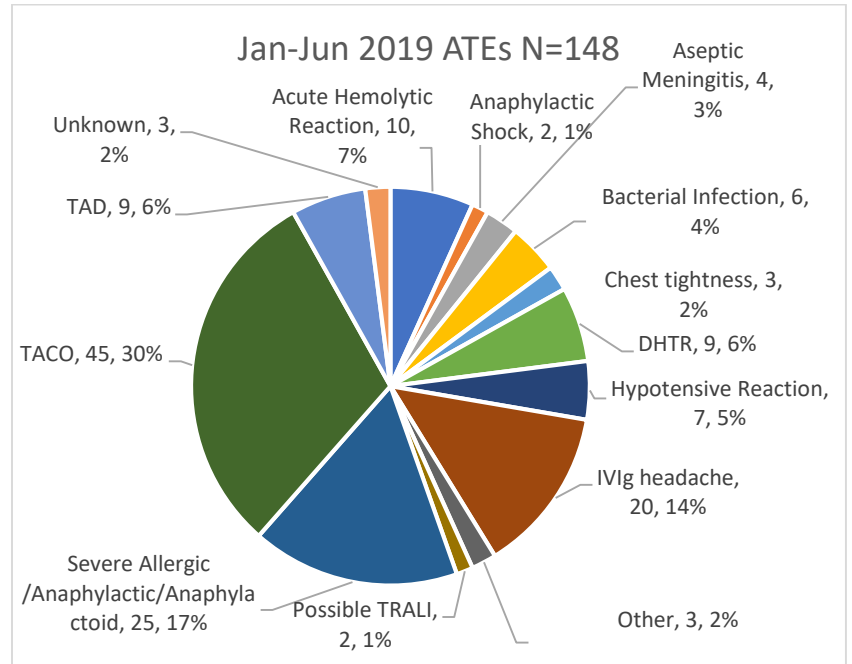
